A Haiku is a traditional Japanese style of poem.
It's easy to write a Hiaku. Have an adult help you if you get stuck.
Here are the steps:

A Hiaku is 3 lines

The 1st line is 5 syllables.
The 2nd line is 7 syllables.
The 3rd line is 5 syllables.

A syllable is like a beat. *For example:*

SCOUT is 1 syllable
FLORA is 2 syllables: FLO & RA
PHINEAS is 3 syllables: PHIN & E & AS
